# Approval of Warrant

### Roads

- Dale Acorn inquired to the width of Right of Way on the Smith Road.
  - o Greg Palman will research though Maine Municipal Association
- A request was made to install a road sign for the Ducktail Pond Road.
  - The Selectboard voted 3-0 in Favor
  - The town will procure the sign and pole for the intersection of Route 9 and the Ducktail Pond Road, and will install.
  - A road crew assembled by Phil Deckers installed hot patch and asphalt on both the Smith Road and the Tannery Loop Road in order to repair potholes and washouts.

  - The Selectboard vote 3-0 not if favor of this change, and will draft and send letters to both the United States Geological Society and the Hancock County Commissioners Office expressing this.

  - Wes Ellington will provide Mrs Knuston the requested list.

## Other Business

- The Selectboard Voted 3-0 to add an Article to the Annual Town Meeting Warrant as to whether the name of Dutton Pond should be changed or not.
- A motion was made to issue a Quit-Claim-Deed to Randy Hayward for the property which went into foreclosure, thus became town owned property. Mr. Hayward's payment was received after the foreclosure deadline.
  - o The Selectboard voted in favor 3-0 of issuing a Quit-Claim-Deed.
