  - The Select Board Voted 3-0 to offer a payment plan of 50% delinquent taxes by 11-30-2019 and the remaining 50% of delinquent taxes owed by 12-31-2019. (This does not include current taxes). If this is not paid by the prescribed date of 12-31-2019 then the foreclosure process will begin.
